General Data Protection Regulation

The European Union (EU) published the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in May 2016. After a two-year transition period, the GDPR will go into effect on May 25, 2018. The GDPR applies to the processing of personal data of all data subjects, including customers, employees, and prospects. The regulation applies to organizations and data subjects in the European Union. Non-compliance with the GDPR may result in huge fines, which can be the higher of €20M or four percent of the organization's worldwide revenues. Information Asset has developed a GDPR accelerator based on Collibra® Data Governance Center.

Overall Framework for GDPR Data Governance Compliance




Figure 1: An end-to-end approach to operationalize data governance for GDPR

Information Asset's GDPR accelerator with Collibra is based on an industry-leading methodology that consists of 16 steps (see Figure 1). Each step in the methodology is operationalized with Collibra Data Governance Center.

- Inventory of GDPR sections and recitals
- Policies, standards, and controls
- Critical data elements (CDEs), such as biometrics and national identifier
- Data standards for CDEs
- GDPR data governance compliance dashboard
- Mapping of GDPR controls to other jurisdictions and regulations, such as Canada's Anti-Spam Legislation (CASL), Singapore's Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA), Australia's Privacy Act, and Russia's Personal Data Localization Law
- Positioning of Collibra GDPR Accelerator with other tools, such as OneTrust®
- Pre-built operating model consisting of custom assets, attributes, and relations
